# Rx Return Drop Boxes Provided for 16 Counties

In the past 6 months, Moundsville Police have reported a steady rise in the use of their Rx Return, donated by the Marshall County Anti-Drug Coalition led by The Marshall County FRN. Word is spreading fast that properly disposing of prescriptions is an easy and very effective way to ensure there are less dangerous substances available in our communities.

Over 200 pounds of prescriptions have been safely collected and disposed in Marshall County alone. This same success story has proven true in other counties that have installed a safe prescription drug disposal box at their local law enforcement offices.

As a result, the United in Prevention project, led by the FRN, is proud to announce that it plans to purchase at least one secure disposal box for the 16 counties in our region. Boxes will be provided for Brooke, Calhoun, Doddridge,

Gilmer, Hancock, Harrison, Marion, Marshall, Monongalia, Ohio, Pleasants, Ritchie, Tyler, Wetzel, Wirt, and Wood counties and should be installed this summer.

Prescription drug abuse is a rapidly rising form of substance abuse in West Virginia. The past decade has seen a 214% rise in accidental death due to prescription medication. Both law enforcement and drug treatment programs across our region report significant rises in prescription drug abuse.

We want to take this opportunity to again thank all the local law enforcement offices that continually support this project. By informing the community of this service, we can all significantly reduce easy access.

If you are interested in safely disposing of unwanted or expired

medications, you can quickly drop them off at the Moundsville Police Department, 608 Tomlinson Avenue, Moundsville. This service is available 24/7 and all submissions remain anonymous.
